Access either the Apple App Store or the Google Play App Store from your mobile device.

Search for your "My AOA" app and download it for free.

Your username and password are the same as your Osteopathic.org login credentials.

Read, like and share the latest news, announcements, and tweets from the AOA in the **News Feed**.

Switch to the AOA Twitter feed by clicking **Twitter** at top of the News Feed screen. You can then share or like posts through your Twitter app.

Use **My AOA** to visit your AOA dashboard on Osteopathic.org. You can view CME reports, check AOA Board Certification details, update information on your AOA record, and more.




Access **Discussions** to post questions and respond to others in the osteopathic community. Your view is personalized based on your practice specialty, volunteer role, and career stage. You can add a discussion of interest to your News Feed by using the (+) Follow option.

Visit **Messages**\* to send direct or group messages to other My AOA app users.

## Navigating the App, via 'More'

**Earn CME** leads to the AOA's list of live and on-demand CME opportunities.

**Events** shows upcoming AOA events that are available through the app.

**Advocacy** has information on the Osteopathic Advocacy Network (OAN) and the AOA's active legislative campaigns.

**AOA Physician Portal** is the one-stop-shop for viewing and accessing AOA certification, OCC status, your current CME report, AOA online learning courses, and self-reporting of your CME credits.

AOA Resources contains links and resources personalized to you.

**JOM** gives quick, convenient access to the *Journal of Osteopathic Medicine* site for the latest research in osteopathic medicine.

**Community\*** is a directory of all AOA members who are registered app users. Connect with your friends and colleagues - view profiles, save favorites and send direct messages.

**My Account** allows you to view or edit your own profile, review any notes you've made and access items you've bookmarked.

Digital Member Card\* displays a QR code for other AOA members to scan and save.

My Schedule\* lists any events that you have saved to your schedule.

**Settings** offers options to update your account details within the app and to manage notification settings.
