

Proposed Amendments to the AOA Bylaws

The following proposed amendments to the American Osteopathic Association (AOA) Bylaws will be presented at the 2025 Annual Meeting of the House of Delegates, which will occur on July 18–20, 2025. The Chief Executive Officer of the American Osteopathic Association has arranged for their posting on the AOA's website, publication in the on-line edition of the *Journal of Osteopathic Medicine* and distribution to the specialty and divisional societies that will be eligible to send representatives to the AOA's House of Delegates.

All amendments require a two-thirds vote by the House of Delegates for approval.

Article VII - Board of Trustees

Section 1-Duties The Board of Trustees shall:

b. Appoint a Chief Executive Officer, a Chief Financial Officer, a General Counsel, and the Editor-in-Chief and shall fix the amount of their salaries and the length of their terms of office. It shall fix the duties of the Chief Executive Officer, Chief Financial Officer, General Counsel, the Editor-in-Chief and all other officials, committees, departments and bureaus necessary to the proper execution of the policies of the Association and not fixed by these Bylaws.
